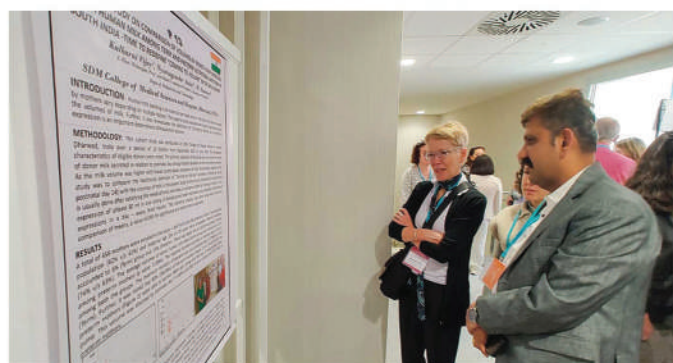

The aim is to provide economically reserved local populations with top-notch services at an affordable cost. So far, 12 ECMO cases have been successfully connected, with a survival rate of 65%.
- The department contributes to medical education through various critical care training programs, including a two-year fellowship program under the prestigious SDM University. Collaborations with ISCCM offer programs like IDCCM, CTCCM, and IDCCN. Additionally, the department runs a BSc Respiratory Therapy program (3+1 years).

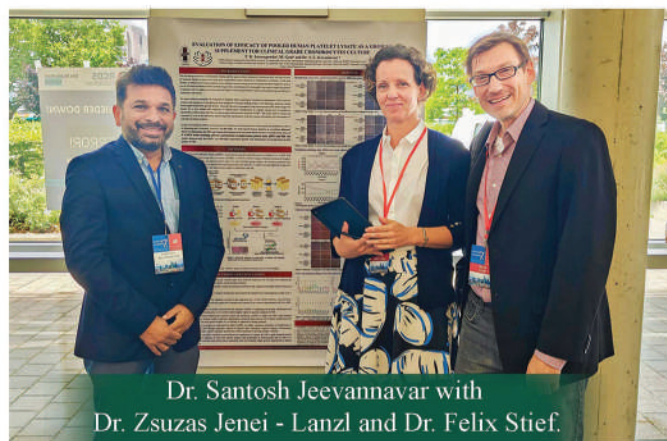


### Special Guest Lecture and Felicitation
