



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## THE LOGO

Poojya Dr D. Veerendra Heggade, Hon'ble Chancellor of the University, while searching for an appropriate Logo for the University, saw a photograph picked from Temple Architecture showing Wings of a Bird, sculpted in Indian style and wanted it to be incorporated in the logo for the University, as the Wings symbolize 'Spreading of Knowledge beyond Boundaries'. Further it was felt that the Central theme of the logo should be 'Rudra' (The Linga) with wings on each side. In this way, the logo of the University was conceptualized.

### Hence:

- 1. The central part represents **Rudra** who Demolishes Darkness.
- The Three horizontal lines on The Linga stand for Samyak Darshan (Right Belief), Samyak Gyan (Right Knowledge) and Samyak Charitra (Right Conduct).
- 3. The **Wings** symbolize spreading of Knowledge across the boundaries.
- 4. Base line "Truth Liberates" highlights the Purpose of Education: to liberate oneself unconditionally. It shows that it is not discipline, nor knowledge nor the efforts to freedom that liberate but Truth is what liberates you from all your conditioning and ignorance.

The overall significance of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara University's Logo is:

Darkness of ignorance is destroyed by the flow of knowledge to bring Liberty to everyone, by realizing the truth. And, it should spread globally without the boundaries as hindrance.

#### Aim

The aim of the fellowship program in Consultation liaison psychiatry is to provide basic and advanced training in Psychiatry to produce competent clinicians, who are able to provide clinical care by collaborating with other faculties in general hospital setting.

#### Goals

Post-doctoral fellowship program provides training in patient care, teaching, research and administration.

Upon completion, the trainee will have acquired the knowledge and clinical skills to manage most Psychiatry conditions co-occuring in other physical conditions and understand the principles and practice of evidence- based care in general hospital setting.

The trainee will also acquire the skills to teach others involved in consultation liaison psychiatry. The trainee will be participating in community psychiatry and routine clinical care in the ward.

#### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Provide in-hospital medical care to patients in the psychiatry ward and other wards with complex medical needs.
- 2. Attend references or other fitness of surgeries as requested by other departments.
- 3. Effectively assess the patient's mental status and judicious use of psychotropics.
- 4. Confirm the history and physical examination on all admissions, document additional findings and generate a problem list and plan of acting,
- 5. Perform/supervise procedure of electro convulsive therapy, brief psychotherapy program for junior residents.
- 6. Be available in hospital for all emergency referrals.
- 7. Collaborate within and other departments in teaching program and research work for study.

Eligibility for Admission - MD or DNB- Psychiatry

**Duration of Course -** 1 year

#### **COURSE CONTENTS**

Since the fellows are trained with the aim of practicing as independent specialists, this course content will be mainly a guideline. The emphasis shall therefore be on the practical management of the problem of the individual cases and the community within the available resources

The broad specialties to be engaged for liaison psychiatry:

#### 1. General medicine:

- a. Comorbid conditions in diabetes and hypertension
- b. Assessment of Deliberate self harm/suicidal attempt
- c. Delirium due to general medical conditions
- d. Behavioral problems in infective/metabolic causes
- e. Electrolyte disturbances

## 2. Obstetrics and Gynaecology

- a. Co morbidities in infertility
- b. Sexual disorders: vaginismus, erectile dysfunction.
- c. Premenstrual dysphoric disorder
- d. Post menopausal mood dysregulation

#### 3. Pediatrics

- a. Childhood epilepsy co morbidities
- b. Learning and speech disorders
- c. Behavioral problems in children with chronic medical conditions
- d. Assessment of autism, ADHD
- e. Intellectual disability disorder

## 4. Gastro enterology

- a. Comorbidities in alcohol dependence and liver disease
- b. Irritable bowel syndrome
- c. Psychogenic vomiting

## 5. Cardiology

- a. Panic disorders
- b. Comorbid depression and anxiety in IHD patients
- c. Post myocardial infarction depression
- d. Health anxiety

## 6. Neurology and Neurosurgery

- a. Dissociative disorders
- b. Post traumatic brain injury
- c. Hypoxic sequelae and behavioral problems
- d. Delirium; Multifactorial
- e. Assessment of drowsy/comatose patient
- f. Comorbidities in Epilepsy

#### **TEACHING / LEARNING METHODS AND ACTIVITIES**

Learning will be self-directed and will take place as a continuous process but in addition the following formal sessions are recommended.

#### Academic session

In addition to attending all the academic sessions, the candidate needs to make a minimum number of presentations (4 seminars, 4 case conferences and 4 Journal clubs) in these academic sessions during the training period of 1 year.

## Presentations to be conducted on one per monthly basis with the following modalities

- a. Seminars / Symposia
- b. Journal club
- c. Clinical case conference
- d. Bedside case presentation and rounds with postgraduate in Psychiatry
- e. Visits to Community health care center as outreach program once a month

Teaching and learning process will also take place during the daily ward rounds and during

teaching rounds.

**Log Book:** The fellow needs to maintain a log book to record all the academic and clinical activities

performed during the one-year duration.

**Clinical postings:** Total period of fellowship course is 12 months during which the fellow will be

working in the Department of Psychiatry, SDMCMSH, Dharwad

Dissertation

Preparation and presentation of a dissertation:

Every Fellow trainee will be required to carry out one research project over 12 months under the

supervision of guide. The project should be completed within 12 months of training, before the

stipulated date of completion of the fellowship course.

**Selection**: candidate will be selected based on written test/interview
