

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
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100 CRORE SHOTS IN THE ARM: INDIA'S MILESTONE IN COVID VACCINATION

India achieved a major milestone in its battle against Covid-19 as cumulative vaccinations in the country crossed the 100 crore mark on Thursday. India is only the second country to have reached the landmark of 100 crore jabs.

While the vaccination graphs of countries with significant populations like the US, Brazil and Indonesia have been largely flat, India's has been rising steeply.

Almost 75% of the eligible population has taken at least the first dose, with eight states and UTs achieving 100% coverage of the first dose. Four more states and UTs have more than 90% coverage of the first dose, according to government data.

SILVER JUBILEE REPORT

It is a great pleasure and privilege to announce that the SDM College of Physiotherapy has completed 25 glorious years this year by the blessings and grace of Lord Manjunatha Swamy and our Reverend President and Chancellor, Poojya Shri D. Veerendra Heggade.



The establishment of SDM College of Physiotherapy, in the year 1996, at Dharwad (Karnataka), is a fine example of the foresight of our Chancellor, Poojya Shri. D. Veerendra Heggade. The First batch was affiliated to Karnataka University, Dharwad which subsequently got transferred to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences and then finally to Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara University in 2019. It was, then one of the very few colleges offering a Degree in Physiotherapy while even colleges in metros offered only Diploma in Physiotherapy. The college was an initiative of the SDME Society with Prof. S. Prabhakar, Shri. D. Harshendra Kumar and Prof. N. Vajrakumar as Secretaries. The College started in a modest way in 1996 on the campus of SDM College of Dental Sciences and Hospital with one classroom and an office and strength of 40 students in the first batch under the leadership of the then Vice-principal, Dr. Glady Samuel Raj. Eventually the college was expanded on the first floor with facilities like library, gym, another classroom and the LASER unit which was the first of its kind in Hubli-Dharwad.





The first outpatient department of Physiotherapy was later inaugurated on 4th September 1997 at the hands of Poojya Shri. D. Veerendra Heggade, while students continued to be posted in

KIMS. Vivekananda Hospital, Railway Hospital, Shivkrupa Hospital and USHAS Centre for Special Children in Hubli with an intention to provide maximum clinical exposure. The first batch of students completed graduation in the year 2000. The college slowly evolved and post graduate courses began in 2003.





The college continued to function in the dental campus until 2004, when the medical college came into being. The college was then shifted to the medical college campus where one whole wing of the building was the physiotherapy college and 1000 sq. feet area for OPD in the hospital building. It was later in 2007 that the college came up with its independent building in its present picturesque location, where it has expanded gradually and steadily in every aspect. Today the college is a constituent unit of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara University, recognised by the Govt. of Karnataka and headed by Chancellor, Poojya Shri. D. Veerendra Heggade, of Shri Kshetra Dharmasthala and Vice Chancellor, Dr. Niranjan Kumar.



The college is in a sprawling 70 acre campus with all amenities. The campus has spacious and well-furnished classrooms equipped with audio visual aids, a library with thousands of books, journals and catalogues along with internet facilities.

On campus hostel and mess for students and facilities like a well-equipped gym, tennis court, swimming pool, indoor court and playground for sports activities for their utilization. The campus today houses a bank, ATMs, cafeterias, prayer hall, stores, auditorium etc. The college is attached to a 1250 bedded multispecialty hospital with numerous wards and ICUs of various specialties.

The highly qualified, experienced and enthusiastic staff is the pride of the college. The college has conducted hundreds of workshops and CMEs in the last 25 years, along with the staff publishing several articles in journals and text books. Staff and students have also won various awards for their work.

A college alumnus is the strength for any institution. The college has since inception trained more than 1000 under-graduates and 200 Post-graduates. A number of our alumni have been placed well across the globe, while many have explored the field of sports physiotherapy and are a part of various sports bodies at State and National levels.


The college offers various courses like Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) in subjects like Musculoskeletal Disorders and Sports, Neurological and Psychosomatic Disorders, Paediatrics, Cardio-Respiratory Disorders, Community Physiotherapy, Sports and Women's Health and also Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) and emphasize the role of research and importance of evidence based practice throughout the courses.

The institution runs independent Outpatient Departments in various specialties like Orthopaedics and Sports, Paediatrics, Neurology Neurosurgery, Community Based and Rehabilitation, Plastic Surgery, Cardiothoracic and Pulmonary Rehabilitation, and Women's Health. The staff, postgraduate students and interns have also served and successfully treated thousands of patients suffering from COVID-19 during the COVID pandemic.

The college also believes what Joline Godfrey rightly states that "All Work and No Play Doesn't Just Make Jill and Jack Dull, It Kills the Potential of Discovery, Mastery, and Openness to Change and Flexibility and it Hinders Innovation and Invention." A number of co-curricular activities, camps and industrial visits are conducted by the college to reach out to the populations which do not have access to the services in order to develop a sense of service to society among the students. Several extracurricular activities are also encouraged by the college through sports and cultural events being held annually at the college level. Students are also encouraged and have been selected to participate in university and national level sports and cultural competitions.

The college has international and national MOUs with University of Manitoba, Canada and Miraj Medical Center's College of Physiotherapy, Miraj respectively. The college has maintained extremely high standards of education since its inception. The students have brought laurels to the institution making it a tradition to secure several ranks and gold medals every year at the University level.

We at SDM College of Physiotherapy believe in nurturing a holistic education which will help the students develop life skills as they acquire knowledge and information. It would not be wrong to say that the college has completed 25 years of Meritorious service to the cause of education. All this would not have been achievable without the unstinted support of the management and able guidance of our Medical Director and Vice Chancellor, Dr. Niranjan Kumar and Smt. Padmalata Niranjan, Executive Director and Member BOG, SDM University. With the blessings and confidence bestowed on us, we hope to achieve still bigger heights and fame in the years to come under the guidance and supervision of the new, young energetic leaders Mr. Saketh Shetty, Director Administration, Dr. Sunil K. M. Principal and Dr. Sanjay Parmar, Vice-Principal, SDMCPT.



2021 REPORT

The year 2021 has surely been a blessing after a stressful and eventful 2020.

The SDM College of Physiotherapy presently has 157 students pursuing BPT in the 3rd and 4th year under RGUHS, Bangalore. 118 students are pursuing their 1st and 2nd year B.P.T., 39 students are pursuing M.P.T. and 3 are pursuing Ph.D. under SDM University.

The college conducted the final exams for various years in the current year 2021, with adherence to all COVID norms. Eight students secured 13 subject wise ranks under the RGUHS, Bangalore. The best outgoing BPT student, Gold Medal was awarded to Ms. Rai Vithika Subramanya. The best outgoing MPT student was awarded to Ms. Shetkar Sailee Satyawan.

The staff published around 11 research publications in the year 2021 and participated in around 43 workshops and conferences. The institution has added 2 new feathers in the cap, in the form of new courses for the Academic year 2021. They include PG programmes in Obstetrics and Gynaecology - 2 seats and Sports - 2 seats. Also there has been an enhancement of MPT. seats in various other branches.

HOSPITAL COVID-19 MANAGEMENT AT SDMCMS&H

The second wave of COVID 19 started around 15th April. 2021 at SDMCMS&H. A lot of challenges were faced. In view of these challenges as a first step the War Room was set up under the leadership of Medical Superintendent adjacent to his office to plan, coordinate & implement operations in time bound situations by Dy Medical Superintendent & Asst Medical Superintendent along with the Post Graduates of the Dept of Hospital Administration.

- With these challenges in mind the team at SDMCMS&H decided to handle the situation in the most scientific way possible with strategic planning & coordinated efforts.
- The needs of the situation were analysed & necessary action was taken in that regard. Beds were increased to cater to increasing case load. All the beds were equipped with necessary equipment & oxygen lines were provided to all. In this regard SDMCMS&H dedicated 378 beds for the treatment of COVID 19 patients. Out of these 300 were general ward beds, 43 were ICU beds. In order to provide for the suspected cases SARI Section was created. It comprised of SARI ward with 25 beds & SARI ICU with 10 beds.
- The wards dedicated to the treatment of the COVID patients were provided with all the facilities including imaging, ensuring isolation & continued quality care to the patients. In view of the patients with renal co-morbidities dialysis sections were arranged in the COVID ward itself for the care of Renal Patients. The diet to the patients were strictly monitored & tailored as per the needs of the individual patients to hasten the process of recovery.
- •Separate Ward was started to care for the pregnant women. The ward was equipped with all the equipment & man power round the clock to provide special care to the pregnant women. Amidst these conditions the OBG team successfully conducted 66 deliveries of COVID 19 affected mothers.
- The Clinical, Para-clinical & support staffs were mobilized adequately for the care of the patients. The staffs were manned round the clock to ensure sustained care. Protective equipment & N95 masks were generously provided for the safety of the healthcare providers.
- •During the Pandemic Oxygen remained the mainstay of treatment. The demand for the oxygen had grown everywhere & maintaining the stock of the Liquid Medcal Oxygen was a challenge. But here it was taken care of effectively. During the second wave the utilisation had reached 4kl per day. With this in mind the supply chain was managed well by the team ensuring adequate stocks at all times. The indenting was planned & done in advance with coordination with the logistics for the procurement on a regular basis.
- The medicines involved in the treatment of the had become scarce during the peak of the pandemic. This condition was tackled by the coordinated effort of the Administration &

Pharmacy Team. The Administration took steps to coordinate with the Government authorities & Private vendors aggressively in procuring the drugs, providing care & support to the patients. Being Patient Centric, the management considered every avenue including procurement of equipment & up gradation of existing one.

- The digital radiograph was procured & used widely in the care of patients which turned out to be very helpful in monitoring the improvement to treatment.
- •Hospital widely provided services to the AB-ARK (government scheme) all the other insurance and cash patients. The insurance processes were taken care of by the insurance team widely thereby easing the load on the patient relatives. SDMCMS&H provided services at free of cost to 582 government referred patients under AB-ARK scheme during the 2nd wave.
- •Dedicated operation theatres were set up for the care of patients requiring surgeries. These OTs were well equipped. All the safety precautions were on par with the Government Guidelines. The Surgery team did a commendable job by performing 171 surgeries to the COVID affected patients.
- •The healthcare workers worked day in & day out with great dedication for the care of the patients & during their services many were infected. In the battle against COVID 19, 157 doctors, 45 nurses & 30 allied health workers were affected. Hospital took great care of the staff members who had been ill. All the services were provided to them free of cost. Logistics support was also provided to help them during the pandemic as transportation was not available.
- The ICU support was intensified by increasing the man power. The Doctors, special mention to staff nurses other support staffs were posted to cater to the special needs of patients wearing the suffocating PPE Kit. All the life support aids were made available round the clock to all the patients at the ICU maximizing the support to the critical patients. The dedicated efforts of all the doctors, nurses & allied staff provided immense help & support to 2,628 COVID19 affected patients. Out of which 2,203 were treated in the general ward & 425 patients in the ICU set up.
- •The COVID 19 testing facility was expanded. Latest techniques of testing & reporting were employed for the benefit of the patients. 32,931 patients availed RT-PCR services & 12,734 patients availed RAT services. SDM RT-PCR Lab was the pioneer in starting the fast-track services to provide the COVID 19 report within 6hours. The SDMCMS&H RT-PCR Lab did an excellent job by providing the reports as per specific guidelines provided by different organizations & countries.
- •On 16th January 2021, Nationwide COVID Vaccination programme was launched. At SDM, a booth was inaugurated by Dr. Niranjan Kumar Vice Chancellor, SDM University, Dr. Rathnamala M. Desai, Principal, SDM Medical College

-Faculty and Students have participated in National Science Day" Poster Presentation Competition organized by SDM University----Received 1 second runner up prize and 2 consolation prizes.


