


FROM THE CHANCELLOR'S DESK

VICE CHANCELLOR'S MESSAGE



I have a dream team which has taken up its responsibilities and is successfully discharging the duties of educating the students and treating all the patients.





HONOURABLE CHANCELLOR'S INTERVIEW

01. "ಕಲೆಗಳಲ್ಲಿ ಪರಮಕಲೆ ಜೀವನದ ಲಲಿತಕಲೆ"

This is one of the famous quote from DV Gundappa's Mankutimmana kagga

Sir as in the above quote you lead an exemplary life We wish to know about your activities on a regular day When does your day start?



As said by you "Living is an art". This can be an inspiration which can be from several sources. I take this from my parents and my routine activities. I start my day at 06.00 am. After freshening up, by 07.00 am I start my prayers. Sharp 07.30 am I am in the temple performing rituals.

By 09.00 am following my breakfast I give time to the devotees who wish to meet me. Here we discuss their problems and try for the solutions. I believe giving ABHAYA which is one of the Chaturdanas of Dharmasthala.

Meanwhile there will be regular administrative work which pops in, which requires guidance from me.

In between these, I have lunch, power nap for about 20 minutes and I do walk in the evening for half an hour.

People belonging to all sects meet me starting from sanyasis, students, farmers, politicians and others to seek suggestions, guidance and blessings which is done accordingly.

02. I remember another quote from Mankutimmana Kagga.

"ಖದ್ದೋತನಂತೆ ಬಿಡುಗೊಳದೆ ಧರ್ಮದ ಚಲಿಸು"

Just like how the Sun works 24 x 7, you tirelessly work Sir. In this active religious and social works of yours, do you actually have some reserve time for your family and friends? Has your family expressed anguish anytime in the past owing to your busy schedule?

"A busiest person has time for all his activities" I strongly believe in this. I do disconnect and reconnect at every moment. I cut off from all the official work during family time and give 100% attention there. I do the same in all my activities which will be mindful.

None of my family members have ever complained regarding this, in fact they appreciate my commitment both in the profession and family.

03. "ಲೋಕಹಿತಂ ಮಮ ಕರಣೀಯಂ"

This quote is very much apt to Heggade family and your close associates. It's been almost 55 years since you have been entrusted with the post of Dharmadhikari of the temple of Justice. You were in your 20's when you were blessed with this major responsibility. Sir, we all acknowledge that you are handsome even now. Dr. Niranjan Kumar Sir says you were no less than a movie hero then. At that youthful age you had an important task to be conducted smoothly. How was the transition then?

I never felt the age then and even now I don't feel it. As said earlier my father was the greatest source of inspiration to me. I always remember his words of wisdom which are the major guiding force to me even today. I used to spend most of my day and night performing temple rituals. In the year 1972, I had the responsibility of pitching in to reformation of JSS Educational Institutions, Dharwad.

With these activities I was kept as 'busy as a bee'. To tell you frankly I am not having time for food and rest since the past few years. Travelling to attend public events, administrative works, temple rituals and other socio-economic reformative activities kept me so busy that I literally had no time to think about myself.

4. Hearing you we can surely say you are leading a disciplined life. From whom and where did you learn this discipline, endurance and patience? Who is your mentor in life or whom do you admire a lot in life?

My parents who sacrificed their entire life for the reformations in Dharmasthala are truly my mentors of life. They practiced and preached "Janaseveye Janardhana Seve" which runs in the family. Seeing them I imbibed discipline, endurance and patience. I am always open for learning. I think this habit of mine has kept me progressing in all fields which I am a part of.

5. If given a choice to dine with 7 of your favourite people (Past and Present) who will they be and why?

I have not given any thought on this. I do follow strict dietary discipline which has run throughout my life. Given a choice I would dine with my family members having home food together as this is the family time I get.

6. Sir, we know that you are "Jack of all trades and interestingly master of all too..." We heard that you are also trained in classical music. As a music lover and an art lover which is your favourite song? Who is your favourite actor?

Since childhood I love Yakshagana and artists and singers of this folk art whom I still admire. Pandit. Balamuralikrishna, Pandit. Bhimsen Joshi, S. P Balasubrahmanyam, Mohammed Rafi, Kishore Kumar are few of my favourite singers. Along with music I give importance to lyrics. "Sajan Re Jhoot Mat Bolo..." is one of my favourites which says never lie as God is watching you.

7. As I discussed earlier there are many religious and social reform activities started by you. It may be in Educational Field, Rural Development Women Empowerment, the Chaturdanas of Dharmasthala and many more. Which among the lot is close to your heart and Why?

Rural development is close to my heart. I believe transformation is the secret of success. If you can transform a person, a society, a generation that is the highest level of contribution. SDM Society initiated rural development in 1982. The transformation since then is commendable. The villagers now are leading a progressive life in the field of farming, education, health and hygiene with financial security.

My better half Smt. Hemavathi Heggade has stood strong with me in all these events. "Self help is the best help" is the motto of about 25000 people working in rural development of SDM Society who have put their heart and soul in this program.

8. I remember a proverb in kannada which is slightly modified by me

" ಆಡು ಮುಟ್ಟದ ಸೊಪ್ಪಿಲ್ಲ, ಹೆಗ್ಗಡೆಯವರು ಮಾಡದ ಸತ್ತಾರ್ಯಗಳಿಲ್ಲ "

Sir, we all have to agree you are a polymath, yet so modest. How do you remain so humble throughout?

Truely, I don't know how. This comes naturally without any effort. Frankly whatever I am blessed with today is only because of grace of lord and blessings from my parents. Whatever brilliant ideas come from any end, I openly accept it and try to implement it for the betterment of the society.

9. Khavandare you are the pioneer in establishing hundreds of SDM institutes and Programs. Few thousands work here. Through this SDM University newsletter if you would like to give few messages to your employees, what would it be?

Entering SDM Institution itself is an opportunity bestowed by the almighty to all the employees who work here including me. Starting from the lowest cadre to highest position all have an equal responsibility. Just like an automobile or any machine which requires thousands of elements for its proper functioning an institution requires adequate efforts from all its employees for its smooth conduction. I expect all my fellow staff members to realise their importance in their work place and perform their duties righteously.



10. In few of the occasions, you have said the present Kaliyuga is a boon as many advancements are happening; meanwhile in the same modern era people are stressed out, loosing courage and are mentally disturbed. Most alarming issue is, it is the youth who are mostly disturbed. As an elder brother what would be your advice to the youth regarding this?

This is a very important topic you have touched on. Youth is a nation's strength. In this modern era there are lot of opportunities waiting to be picked. One has to have eyes to see them. We need to understand life's reality, adjust accordingly with realistic expectations. Youngsters should think how they can contribute for the nation's success and provide a better future for the next generation. Never shy away from your responsibilities.

11. This year is a celebration mode for all your fans including me as we are celebrating the Amrutha Mahotsava of your birthday. On this joyful occasion we wish to know your thoughts and plans regarding future social reforms.

There are multiple thoughts and plans which are blossoming in many fields of SDM Society. 
'Prerana Shibira':

University Convocation:




University Anniversary Celebration:

Ph.D. Symposium:





Teachers Day Celebrations:





























Department of Critical Care Medicine:

- This 30-bedded tertiary referral department boasts a multidisciplinary team of Intensivists, dedicated Critical Care Nurses, Perfusionists, Respiratory Therapists, Dieticians, Physiotherapists, and Bio-Medical professionals. The collaboration extends across various departments, fostering holistic patient care. It is equipped with state-of-the-art technologies. The department offers advanced services including CRRT, Plasma Exchange, IABP, ECMO services, and NAVA ventilation, ensuring the highest quality of care for critically ill patients.
- Pioneering the way, the department initiated a full-time ECMO program with a Retrieval Unit in September 2022. The aim is to provide economically reserved local populations with top-notch services at an affordable cost. So far, 12 ECMO cases have been successfully connected, with a survival rate of 65%.
- The department contributes to medical education through various critical care training programs, including a two-year fellowship program under the prestigious SDM University. Collaborations with ISCCM offer programs like IDCCM, CTCCM, and IDCCN. Additionally, the department runs a BSc Respiratory Therapy program (3+1 years).



• The department has not only excelled in medical care but also in community engagement. The "Critical Care Awareness Month - May 2023" was a month-long event that combined academics, public outreach, and cultural awareness. 




Special Guest Lecture and Felicitation




CLUB ACTIVITIES


